- Review and Final input of building options (September 21)

- Communicate information to the organization you represent regarding project developments
- In addition:
 - Engage in dialogue related to community values and goals in context of new Dixon Public Library conceptual design
 - Identify information gaps to be addressed by project team
 - Identify and share issues of community concern and opportunities to address
 - Assist in identification of additional stakeholders with an interest in the Dixon Public Library conceptual design
 - Support project team efforts to communicate effectively with Dixon Public Library stakeholders
