## POLICY AND PROCEDURE HANDBOOK

**POLICY TITLE: Library Commission**

**POLICY NUMBER: 7000**

**7000.1** The Governing Board of Library Trustees may choose to appoint a five-member Library Commission to exercise oversight and authority for library district services and operations by virtue of the provisions of California Education Code section 18440.

**7000.1.1** Before the Governing Board of Library Trustees may appoint a Library Commission, it shall hold at least one public hearing on the matter of the creation of a library commission. Notice shall be given by publication pursuant to Section 6066 of the Government Code, in a newspaper designated by the Governing Board, and by posting the notice in three (3) public places in the Library District at least fifteen (15) days prior to the date of the public hearing.

**7000.1.2** The official name of the Commission shall be the Dixon Public Library District Library Commission.

**7000.1.3** The Governing Board of Library Trustees may dissolve the Library Commission effective as of the 30<sup>th</sup> day of June next succeeding. Before the Governing Board of Library Trustees may dissolve the Library Commission, it shall hold at least one public hearing on the matter of the dissolution. Notice shall be given by publication pursuant to Section 6066 of the Government Code, in a newspaper designated by the Governing Board, and by posting the notice in three (3) public places in the Library District at least fifteen (15) days prior to the date of the public hearing.
